Can you remember them? The Legendary movie and TV-series of the 60s and 70s like „Breakfast at Tiffany´s“, „The Thomas Crown Affair“, „Bullit“, „UFO“ or „Columbo“... Besides all of their their unique design, legendary casting and coolness, they also shared one thing in common:

unforgettable music.

The sixties was a golden age for lounge music - this reminds us of orchestras in the likes of Henry Mancini, Les Baxter, Hugo Montenegro or Percy Faith.



We all feel a strong attraction to these sounds, even to the time and lifestyle itself. 2 years ago in Vienna there emerged the idea to create a 17 people orchestra called „Velvet Elevator“, which was done by Heinz Fallmann and Martin Ptak.

The cineastic arrangements spread from early 80s TV series over 70s „car race movies“ to Bossa Nova, Funk, Cha Cha, Jazz, and they were written especially for this group.

You can hear pieces of well-known composers like Lalo Schifrin, Ennio Morricone, John Barry, Michel Legrand, Antoine Sabé, Antonio Carlos Jobim, Francis Lai, Barry Gray, Benny Golson,...
